

Dear colleagues,

As we announced, here are the updates about the Split/Mostar Euroclassica conference.

By June 25 the representatives of only 7 member associations confirmed their arrival. This is, of course, not enough for a proper Euroclassica conference to take place.

Apart from that, in Southeast Europe, the things with the pandemics are getting worse. After a few weeks without new cases, as a consequence of loosening the restrictions there is now a new, sharp rise, both in Croatia and in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The borders between the two countries are again temporarily closed and it becomes clear that over the course of summer the rules will change on a daily basis.

In the light of all this, despite our wishes, we decided, with the support of the President of Euroclassica, to cancel the event for this year. The colleagues from Split and Mostar will be happy, *dis iuuantibus*, to host the conference in 2021.
